High Winds Result in Some City Power Outages

Thunder Bay, ON – High winds overnight resulted in various power outages around the city. Over the breakfast hours an estimated 500 customers were without power. Reasons included a blown transformer in the Ravenwood Crescent area, and falling trees on power lines.

Crews began trouble work at midnight. Outage issues within the city were resolved by mid morning.

The public is urged to contact Thunder Bay Hydro if they notice a tree blown onto a power line within the city limits. During the day, they can call customer service at 343-1131. After 5:00 pm they can call 343-1002.
